“ I first met Wayne at work in late Jan 1974 after Sandy, Amy and I had arrived at Hanscom AFB. He had been assigned as my military “sponsor” to help me in my transition both to Hanscom AFB and to serving in the AWACS Program Office. He was very good to me and helped my adjustment process in many ways. I do not recall details, but I am sure that he introduced me to many people within the AWACS Program Office, helped me understand the AWACS program and how the program office functioned, as well as telling me a lot about living in Massachusetts. During our first 4 months or so, our family lived in 4 different places while we waited for a base housing unit to become available. What turned out wonderfully for us is that when we finally were able to move on base, our building was just a few yards behind the building in which your family lived. That location made it very easy for us to get to know each other as families during the summer of 1974, and we became good friends. Starting then and until your family left Hanscom in 1976, we were in each other’s homes many times; also we did several enjoyable things together such as visiting parks, having picnics, eating out, attending church, etc. One evening, Wayne, Linda, Sandy and I went out to eat at a Korean restaurant in Cambridge – our first taste of Korean food! Wayne gave us his recipe for bulgogi, which became one of our family’s favorites. Sandy and I have many pleasant memories of our times together with the Hardins!

I certainly appreciated Wayne’s abilities and skills in production management for AWACS, and had the chance to see him in action on several occasions. He was a very sharp officer, and I was very happy when he received his promotion to Major.

Sandy and I were also very glad for the two chances we had, in recent years, to have dinner with Wayne and Linda when we were passing through Scottsboro on our way to Huntsville to see our son, Dan and his family. It was so special to be able to “catch up” during those times, after not having seen each other since 1980 in Durham, NC. Wayne surely had many neat experiences over the years. Sandy and I enjoyed speaking with Linda, both this past Friday and earlier this morning.
