June 11, 1943 - February 16, 2023

Carl W. Phillips, 79, passed away Thursday, 16 February 2023 at Crestwood Hospital in Huntsville. Carl was born on 11 June 1943 to James A and Pearl A Phillips in Olympia, Wash. He attended Olympia High School.

At the age of five Carl knew he wanted to join the Navy and did in 1961. Carl served several tours in Vietnam and during the twenty-two years of his service he was on the USS Coral Sea, USS Anchorage, USS King and USS New Orleans.

Upon his retirement from the Navy he went to Centralia Community College and joined Boeing BCSS in Seattle in 1985 working as a communications engineer. In 1986 he was transferred to Harrisburg, PA and in 1988 was transferred to Huntsville where he continued working until his retirement in 2007.

Carl was an avid sports fan and enjoyed bowling. He was also a collector of baseball cards and coins and a Corvette enthusiast owning several over the years.

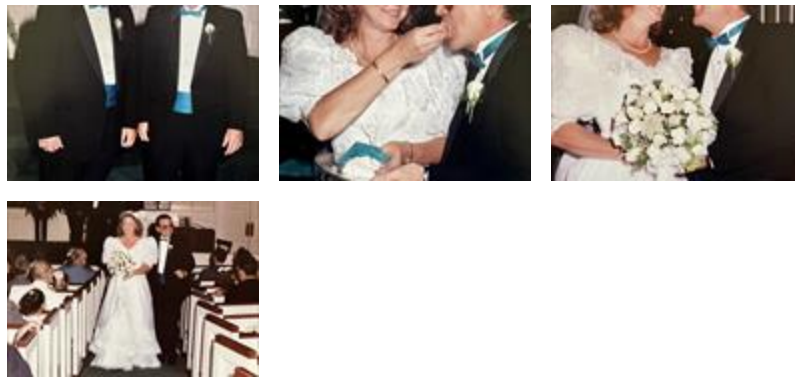
