He not only could play basketball but i remember one time they put him on cotton nash of Kentucky and Bambi held him to two points. When we needed somebody to be a little rough with somebody it was Bambi because he could sure guard em. One time we went to the university of Georgia and somehow we lost by 1 point. Bambi was going to the locker room and he was crying because we lost and some Georgia student said something smart thats when Bambi Howland took the whole student body on. People were running & fists were flying. He wooped the whole student body. Me and Bambi worked at the central foundry one summer, building pipes. I liked to have died and Bambi just sat there and smiled. We would go sell blood at druid city hospital for \$15 and head to Florida. I can remember the 5 or 6 times we did that. They said i got Bambi in trouble all the time but it was the other way around, Bambi got me in trouble, got me kicked off scholarship 5 times and would just sit there and smile. I cannot believe that Bambi has passed. Im so sorry today that I did not get to see him again. Because i still have the love in my heart as his friend. We had lots of great times.
