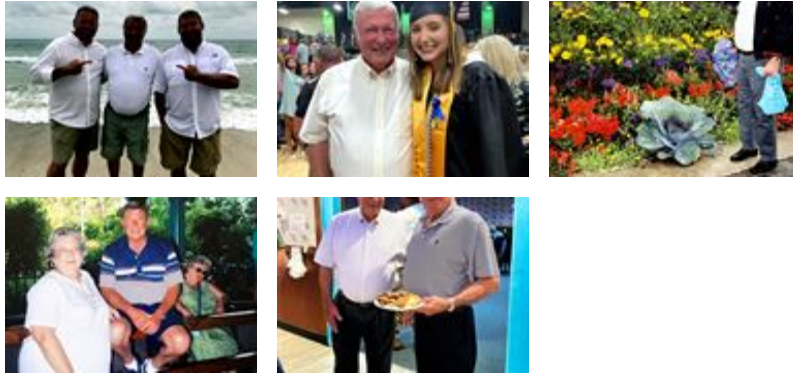
“ I remember Mr. McCray from years ago. He would be patrolling the South Sauty area and they would eat at the Cafe at the SS store. He was always a very nice man.
