Rev. Charles Willmon, age 86 of Scottsboro, Alabama passed away Saturday, December 26, 2020 at Huntsville Hospital.

Charles was born on November 23, 1934 in Marshall County, Alabama. The oldest child of Lawrence David & Cuba Laney Willmon, Charles lived a full and blessed life. A true servant, Bro. Charles served as a pastor for over 50 years. He also served more than 50 years in banking.

A funeral service will be held at 2 p.m. Monday, December 28, 2020 at Rainsville Holiness Church, the last church he pastored. Rev. Ollie Taylor and Rev. Ricky Wooten will officiate.
