Eva Mae Lewis was born October 11, 1936, in Jackson County, Alabama to Thomas Clifford Rounsavall and Mary J. Anderson Rounsavall. She graduated from Scottsboro High School and has remained closely connected with her classmates. She married Howard R. Lewis in 1969, and he preceded her in death in 1989. He is remembered by many for having served as deputy sheriff, policeman and detective in Scottsboro for more than 20 years. Mrs. Lewis is well known to area residents for having clerked at Hammer's Department Store for nearly 40 years. She considered her fellow employees at Hammers's to be like family. She loved sewing and crafting and made beautiful items which she gave away to family and friends. She was a member of Center Point Baptist Church.

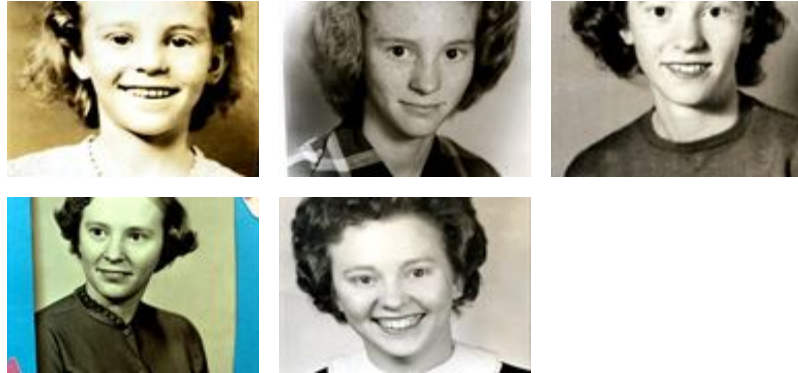
