Evelyn Ruth Buxser Cregar, 93, passed away June 16, 2015 in Scottsboro, Al.

Born April 14, 1922, in Justus, Ohio, she was the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Earl Buxser of Justus. She served as a Yeoman in the U.S. Navy during World War II. She attended Otterbein College for a short time before enrolling at Ohio State University where she earned a bachelor's degree in business. She would later work in Civil Service at Redstone Arsenal in Huntsville, Al. For the past 13 years she resided in Auburn, Al., most recently at Monarch Estates. Her final residence was at Rosewood Manor in Scottsboro.

She was preceded in death by her husband, William Evan Cregar, a sister Louise Muris and a brother, Dick Buxser.

A sister, Mary Jean Buxser of Ohio; four children, Terry Scott Cregar of Seneca, SC, William Todd Cregar of Atlanta, Ga., Karen Elizabeth Stephenson of Auburn, and Cynthia Ann Wood of Hollywood, Al., eight grandchildren and five great-grandchildren survive her.

Her remains will be buried at a later date, alongside those of her husband, at Maple Hill Cemetery in Huntsville. A Memorial Service will be held at that time.
