“ I met George in 1956 when I joined the Lambda Chi (LXA) at Georgia Tech: he was known as Dayton at the fraternity. He majored in Textile Engineering there and graduated in 1958. He was active in the fraternity, especially in intramural sports.

I lost contact with Dayton after we graduated. We re-connected at a LXA reunion in Atlanta in the 1990's and met Joanne, his wife. We usually go to Hilton Head Island (HHI) one or 2 times a year. We started having a meal with them at some local restaurant. Later we played golf with them at their Golf Club.

Sometimes we would have a small gathering of fraternity brothers for a meal at HHI. Joanne was usually the person who selected a place and made the arrangements. Sometimes we would have a glass of wine at their lovely home. She was a lovely person; she and my wife became friends.

In recent years, Dayton was unable to go out to eat so we talked with him on the phone. A year or so ago we received a call from Dayton that Joanne had died. The next time we were at HHI, Philip Meadows (another fraternity brother) and I and our wives had a short visit with him at his house. He was already planning to sell the house and move to a retirement community.

We visited him several times at Bayshore; sometimes the two of us, sometimes with Philip Meadows. We were all distressed to see his condition since we had known him as an active person.
