Irene Machen Gist passed from this life on Sunday, January 28th. She was born on August 2, 1932, to Evelyn and Aubrey Machen. While growing up in Hollywood, Alabama, Irene learned the importance and value of hard work. At the age of seven, she went to work as sales person and cashier of her Daddy's "rolling store". She carried the work ethic learned at a young age throughout her life.

Soon after graduating, Irene married her high school sweetheart, Leroy Gist. They worked together for over fifty years at Gist Studio. Irene's strong work ethic and eye for artistic details helped capture images that are still treasured by many families today. The two of them also worked together in several different benevolent and outreach ministries of the Broad Street Church of Christ. Their church family always meant a lot to both of them. Irene and Leroy were married for 64 years before his death in 2014.

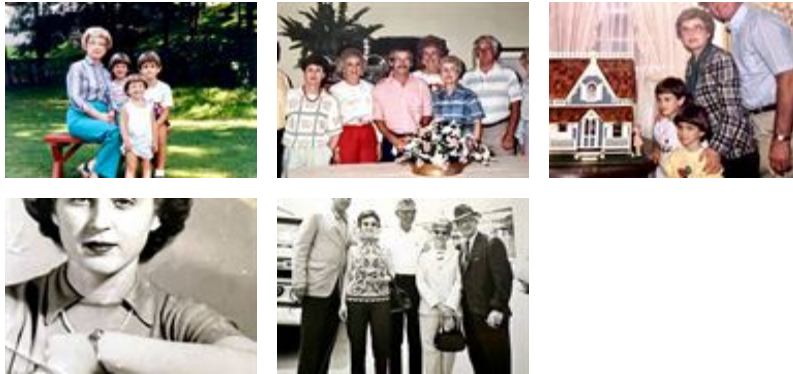
