Mr. James Steven (Jimmy) Robertson, 70, of Scottsboro, AL, passed away at his home on Wednesday, August 18, 2021.

Having a love for journalism, he landed his first job in newspaper as a sports reporter for the Daily Sentinel while still in high school. His career with Southern/Hartman Newspapers spanned 37 years, publishing papers throughout Central and East Texas.
