Lela Anne Wilson, of Scottsboro, Alabama, passed away at the age of 89 on February 11, 2026. Mrs. Wilson grew up in Navoo, Alabama, and graduated from Carbon Hill High School. After high school, she was working in Birmingham when mutual friends introduced her to Max Wilson, whom she fell in love with at first sight. Lela and Max married in 1963. They loved and supported one another and raised five boys.

Ms. Wilson, later, while working as a school bus driver and raising a family, completed her bachelor's and subsequently her master's degree in elementary education. Combining what she learned in college with her experience managing the chaos of raising a houseful of boys, she became a well-known and dearly loved sixth-grade teacher. 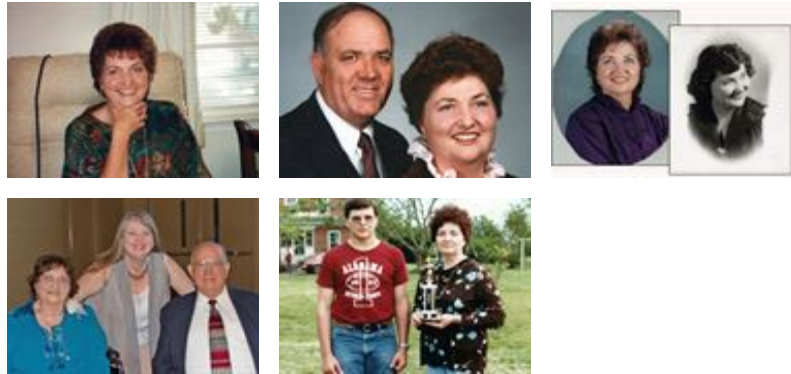
