This incredible woman IS Lenore. She was a classmate, a co-worker and a friend. Her light and her shine will be missed by many who knew and loved her.

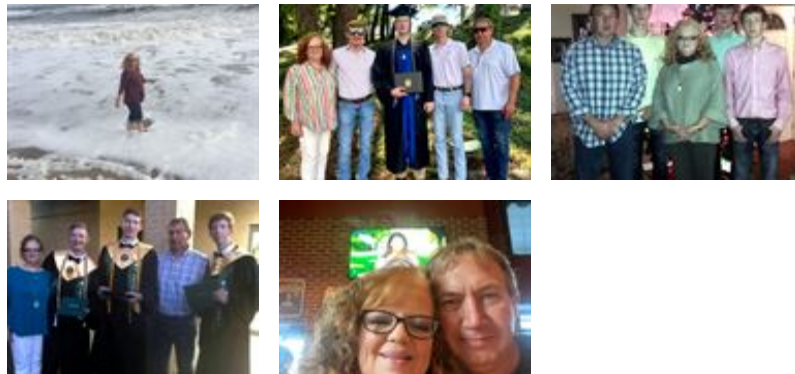
