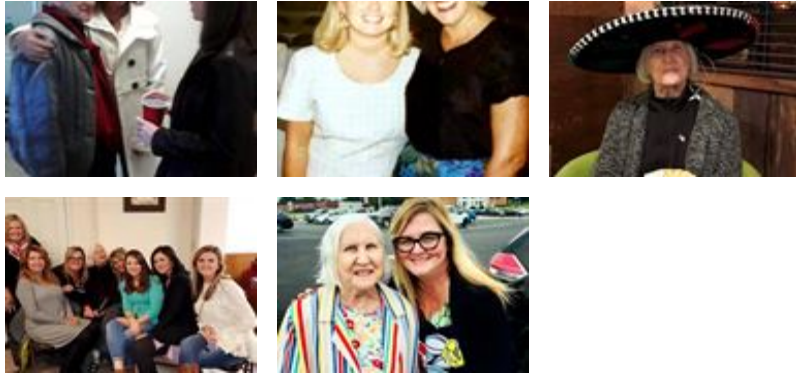
“ *What a remarkable woman, the Pat I remember. I do not believe I have ever met a woman with more passion, energy and drive. Our first meeting was at Jackson county park-
