Mr. Ronald L. Cleaver, 83, of Scottsboro, passed away on Tuesday, July 5, 2022. Ron was born in Lafayette, Indiana in 1938 and graduated from Purdue University with a degree in forestry. For almost 25 years, he was the general manager over the saw mill with Mead.

He was an active member of the First United Methodist Church. He volunteered with the Nourish One Child there, along with serving on different committees. His biggest passion was trees and he served until he passed away with the Tree Commission.

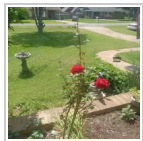

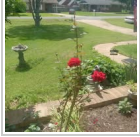

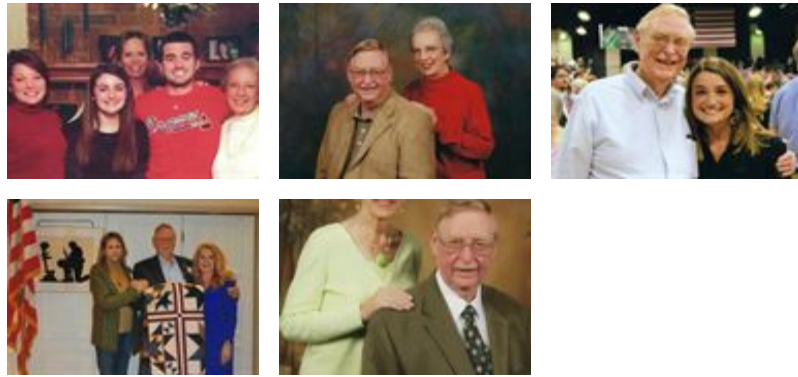
