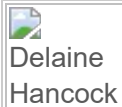


Celeste Pittman

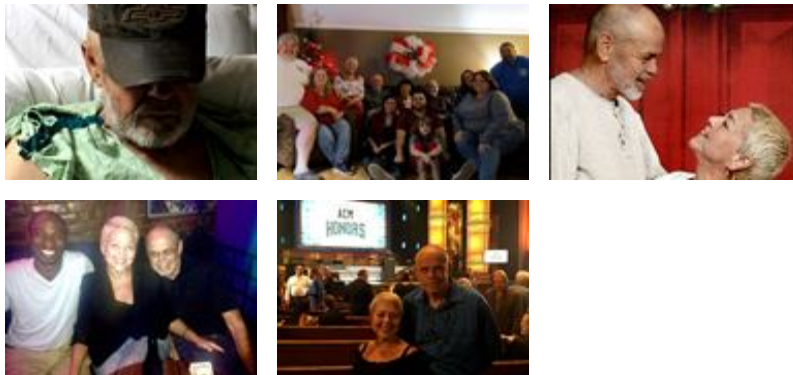
