



Bishop William "Billy" Wilson

June 11, 1931 - June 15, 2017

Bishop William (Billy) Mark Wilson, 86, of Sauk Village, Illinois, formerly of Estill Fork, AL passed away Thursday, June 15, 2017.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, June 22, 2017 at 3:00 p.m. from Scottsboro Funeral Home. Burial will follow in Wilson Cemetery in Estill Fork, AL. The family will receive friends on Thursday, June 22, 2017 from 11:00 a.m. until 3:00 p.m. at the funeral home.
