William Walker (Bill) McCutchen passed away on Wednesday, March 20 at the age of 80.

Bill was a 1951 graduate of Scottsboro High School where he was a standout football player, earning a scholarship to the University of Georgia. He later transferred to the University of the South where he played football, graduating in 1955 with a degree in business administration. He coached football at Butler High School in Huntsville where he met the love of his life, Peggy Bobo McCutchen, who preceded him in death in 2008 after 52 years of marriage.

He served as an officer in the US Air Force, traveling to all parts of the globe including a trip to Antarctica.

He returned to Scottsboro where he served on the Scottsboro Board of Education and worked for many years in the manufacturing industry. After his retirement, he enjoyed working in the Pro Shop at Goose Pond Colony Golf Course.

Bill was a member of the First United Methodist Church, a former scoutmaster, member of the Scottsboro Lions Club & the Scottsboro Quarterback Club and was actively involved in numerous civic affairs. He was an avid hunter and fisherman and enjoyed spending time with his children and

grandchildren. At the time of his death, he was co-owner of the McCutchen Magnolia House with his sister.

In addition to his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents, William Walker McCutchen and Mary Snodgrass McCutchen.

He is survived by his children – Bill (Vickie) McCutchen of Northport, Alabama, Carole (Mark) Thorsen of Huntsville, Alabama, Ted McCutchen and Howard McCutchen both of Scottsboro, Alabama, eight grandchildren, three great grandchildren and sister – Mary Gene McCutchen of Scottsboro, Alabama.

Visitation with the family will be Friday, March 22, 2013 from 6:00-8:00pm at the Scottsboro Funeral Home and services will be Saturday, March, 23, 2013 at 11:00am at the First United Methodist Church with Dr. Steven Screws officiating and Robert Clemons delivering the eulogy.
